Understanding and addressing social support needs of adults with disabilities

Our research team is focused on how to better "hear" the voices of adults with disabilities. We are concerned that voices of adults with disabilities are under-represented in research and may get lost or overshadowed by the louder, clearer voices of others.

We want to interview adults with disabilities together with one or both of their caregiving parents. We want to examine how adults express themselves when their parent is present and what researchers can learn from these interactions.
